Other helpful membership information:

- The Cigre membership year runs from January to December, so any organisation signing up now would be paying for the year Jan 2016 to Dec 2016.
- Membership fees are paid in full in advance
- Membership fee payment options are cheque, BACS transfer (in the future we looking into payment by debit or credit card but this is not currently available)
- VAT is payable on the UK element of the membership fee, however, VAT is not applicable to the Paris element of the fee
- CIGRE UK is in the process of getting CIGRE UK registered with HMRC so that in the future taxpayers can claim Professional fee tax relief
- For Members (Collective & Individual) to qualify for the discounted registrations fees for the Paris Session, they are required to be a member of Cigre in the Session year **and** the preceding year i.e. for the 2016 Paris session they must be a member in 2015 & 2016 (membership saving is approx. €200/person for Paris Session)

Notes:

¹ Introductory rate applies to applicants for Collective 1A & 1B membership only. To qualify, the organisation applying must not have been a collective member of Cigre previously, and it should be made clear that they will revert to 1A or 1B membership rate in year two and beyond.
